**Key Themes: Victorians, Local History, Tourism, Transport** 

## **Learning Objectives:**

• Recognize how the different trades practiced in Cromer changed after the arrival of the railways, and understand how this encouraged people to move to the area.

- Understanding how tourism increased after the introduction of the railways.
- Learn how we can use documents to find out about the past.

30 mins	Trade directory	Go round the classroom picking up items from to do list.  Explain activity  Ask for volunteer to put on hat and wave flag so you can travel back in time.
