What contribution have refugees made to the history of Norfolk?

Key Stage: 2

Type: Online Length 45 minutes

Curriculum links: Citizenship, History Key Themes: Refugees, Local History

Learning Objectives:

- Understand which groups have taken refuge in the county, and what they have brought to the local area.
- Discover the main reasons refugees leave their home countries.
- Find out how many refugees have created new and successful lives for themselves, including Jewish refugee Lewis Ecker and his family.
- Understand the difficulties in refugees might have in deciding what to take with them when fleeing a country.

10 mins	Why come to Norfolk?	Look at certain conflicts from the timeline (then make one of the cards appear to the bottom corner and ask what was the cause and effect of that conflict on those people). Discuss in small groups why each of those people came to the country.	ppt	Class
