What contribution have refugees made to the history of Norfolk?

**Key Stage: 2** 

Type: Online Length 45 minutes

Curriculum links: Citizenship, History Key Themes: Refugees, Local History

## **Learning Objectives:**

• Understand why Dutch and French refugees took refuge in the county, and what they have brought to the local area, including the known as the Strangers

• Find out what the Strangers first impressions were on arriving in Britain and Norwich.

- See how the Strangers integrated into Norwich society by looking at some of their possessions from probate inventories.
- Understand what the Strangers brought to the local area and their legacy.

5 mins	Introduction	Why were the strangers in Norfolk.	ppt	
15 mins	Letters from the Strangers	Explain how we know the information contained in some of the letters send home when the strangers first arrived.  Answer questions on these letters in order to discover the Strangers thoughts and feelings.	ppt	Pairs

10 mins	Strangers Possessions	Have a look at some of the clothes and other possessions the strangers	Ppt	class
		had from their probate inventories.		
15 mins	Packing a suitcase	Show the pupils the objects on the screen (all on one screen together)	ppt	Small groups
		Ask them to imagine they are Lewis Ecker and his family, and to choose 7 of the items to take with them when fleeing the country.		
		Ask them to think of something else that might also be useful if they were to flee today. Report back.
